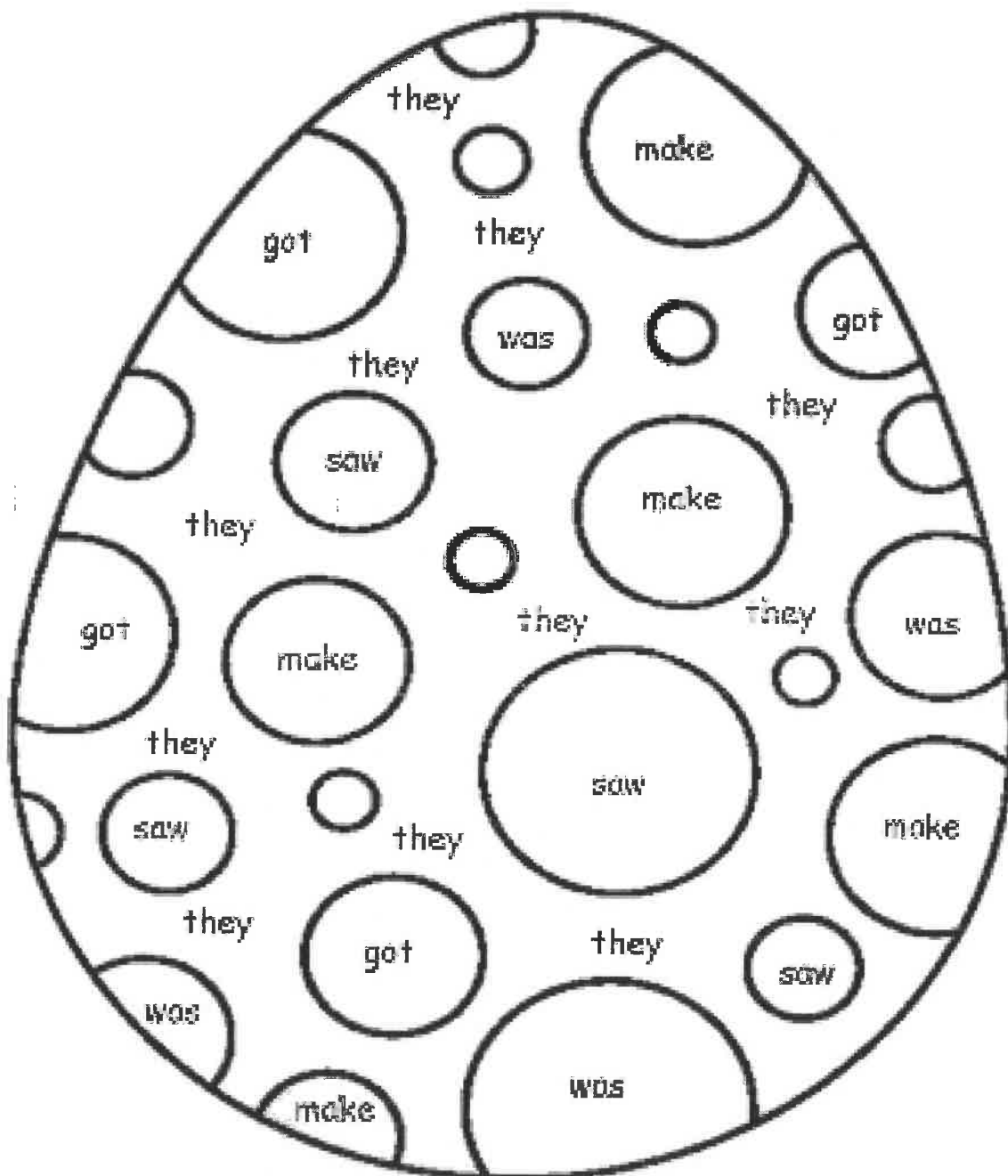

Matthew 21:8



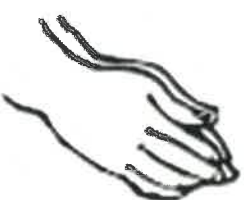

Matthew 26:33-35



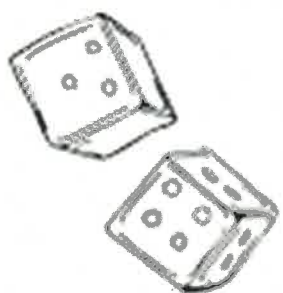
The next day at the farther end of the town on the ground, praying, "My Father! If it is possible, let this cup of suffering be taken away from me. Yet I will do what you will," he said.

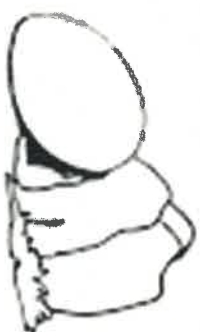
The soldiers made a crown of thorns, sharp thorns and put it on his head and they put a royal purple robe on him.  
John 19:2



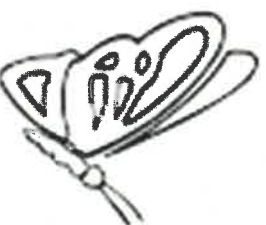
Then the soldiers nailed him to the cross.

Matthew 27:59-62



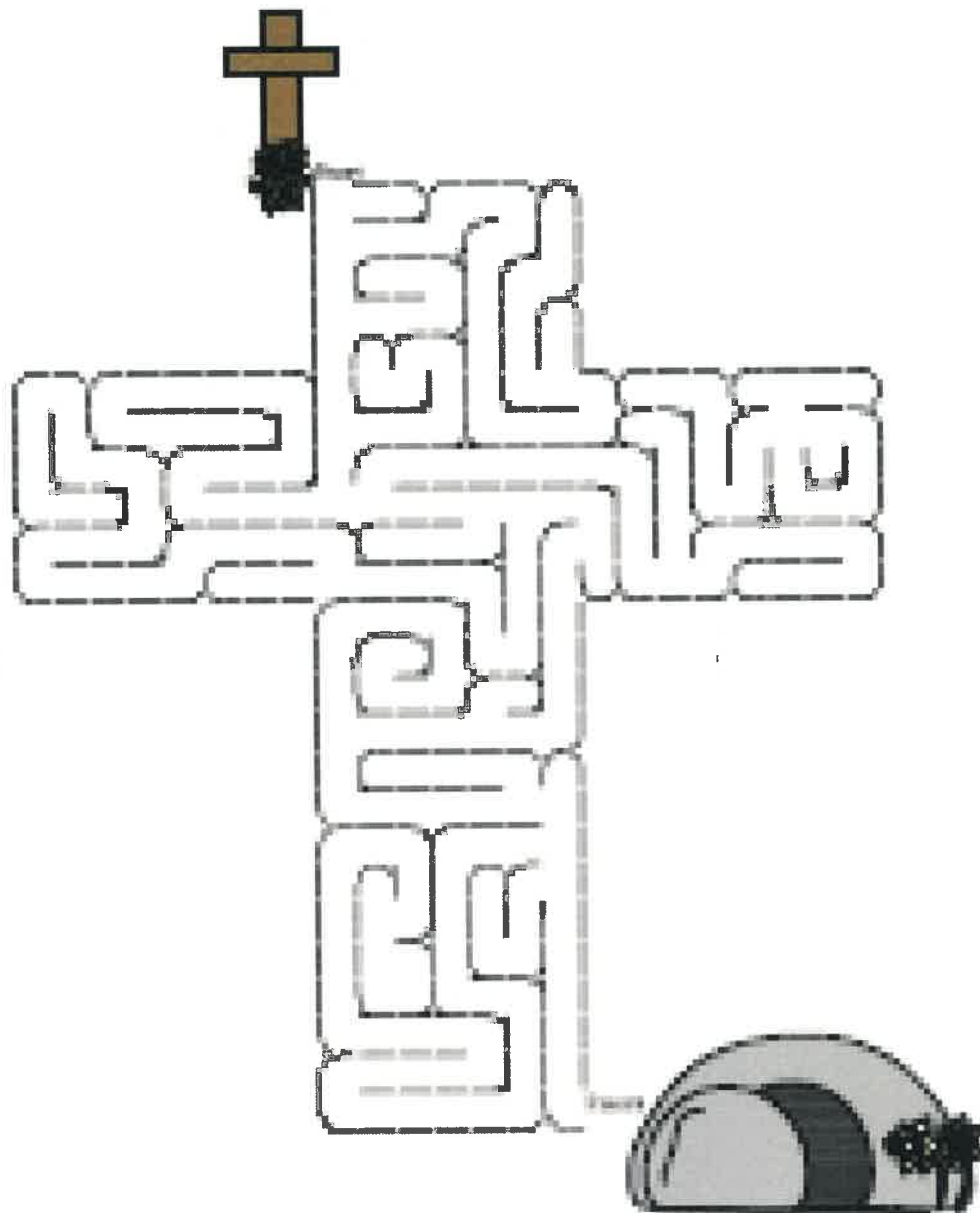
The men buried the body in a tomb. But the next day, the tomb was empty. The women found the stone rolled away.

## Cross Maze

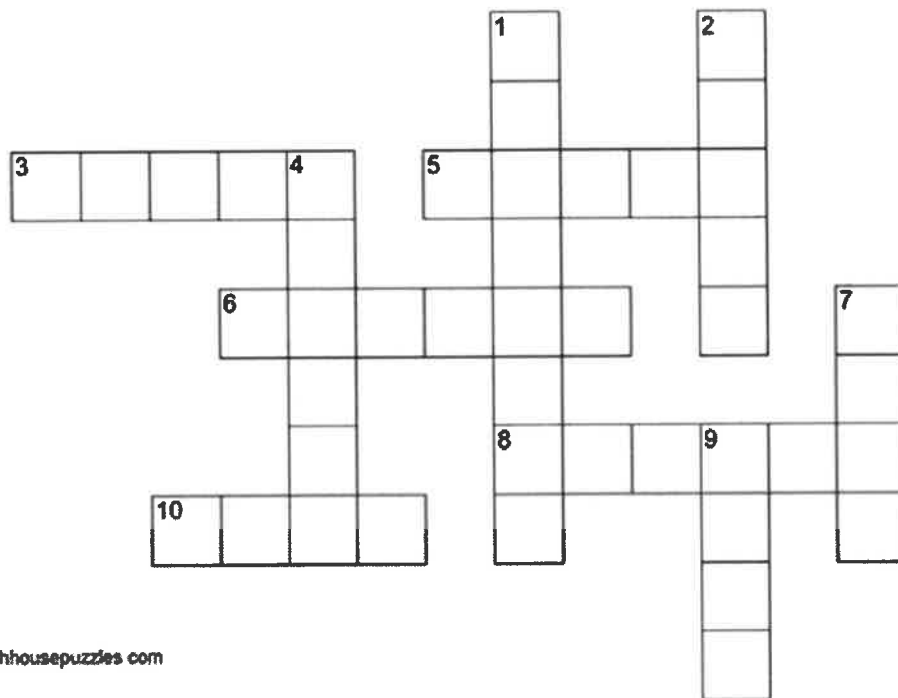
Go through the maze starting at the cross and ending at the tomb without crossing any lines.
